



Mallet of Luck

The mallet of luck is well known in Japan as the item that Daikoku, one of the Seven Lucky Gods, carries with him. Daikoku is the god of fortune and relationships. It is said that hitting the mallet of luck will cause any kind of wish to come true, and that Daikoku granted many wishes with it. It is also featured in many Japanese fairy tales.



★ Assembly Instructions

- 1) Carefully cut out the parts.
- 2) Fold along the dotted lines, making mountain or valley folds as indicated.
- 3) Follow the order indicated in the instructional diagrams, and attach the parts to assemble.
(Read the Explanation of Symbols for more information.)
- 4) Your paper craft model is finished!

★ Tools

Scissors, glue (We recommend craft glue.)

★ Caution

Keep glue away from small children.
Be careful not to cut your fingers when using scissors.

★ Explanation of Symbols

Cut line

Mountain fold

Valley fold

● glue tabs
Glue tabs used to assemble each part.

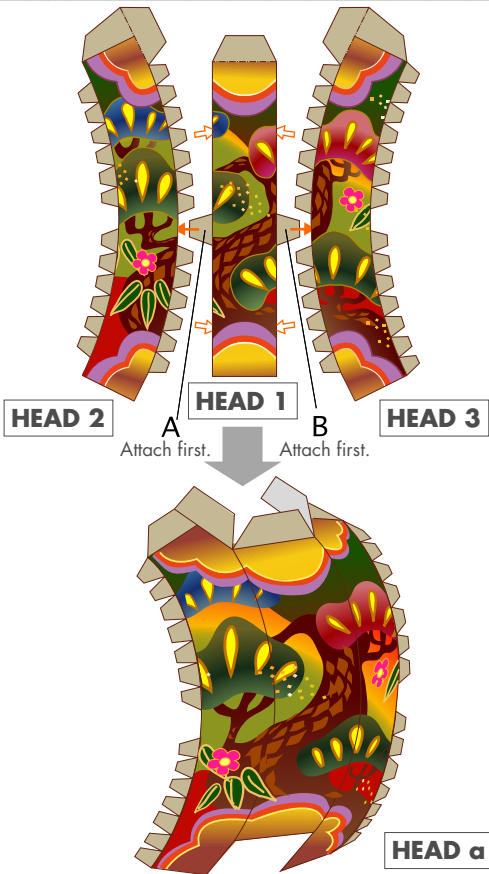
● glue tabs
Glue tabs used to join different parts together.

Glue tabs with alphabet letters
When joining two parts together, attach these glue tabs first.

Attach so that the ▲ comes between the △.

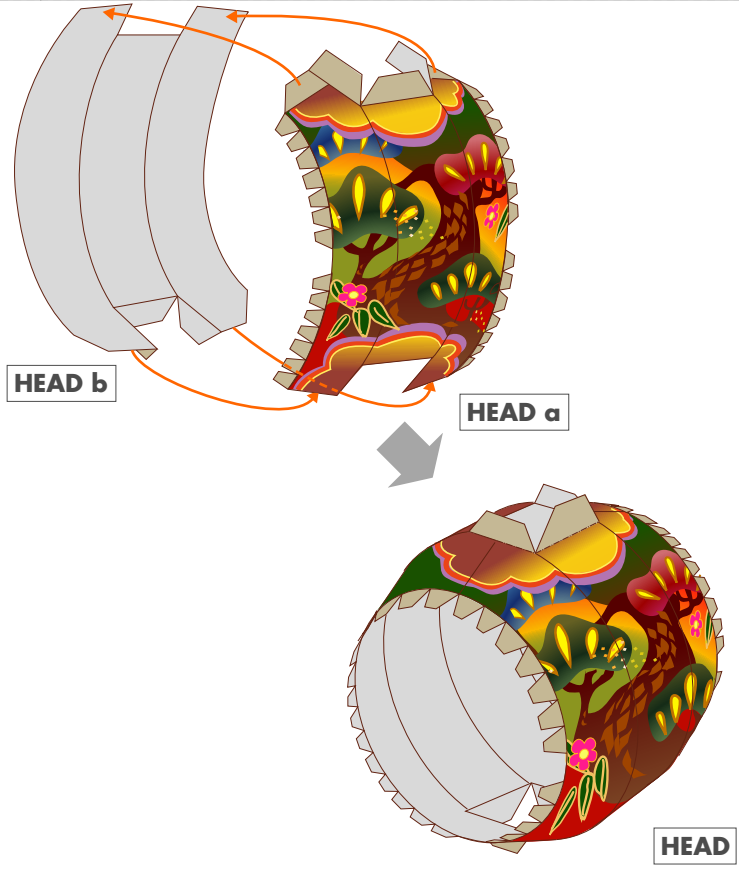
★ Assemble the head

1 Glue the head(1/2/3)

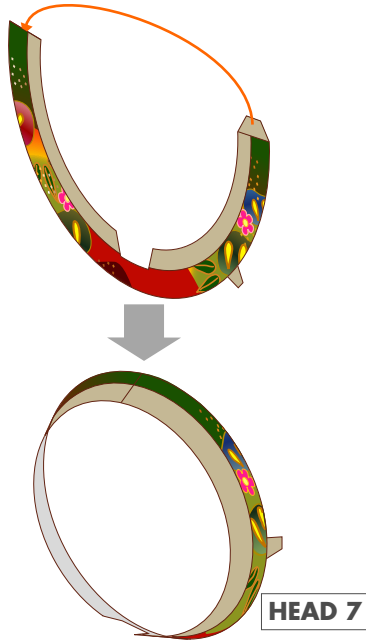


*Attach parts 4, 5 and 6 of the head in the same way (head b).

2 Head

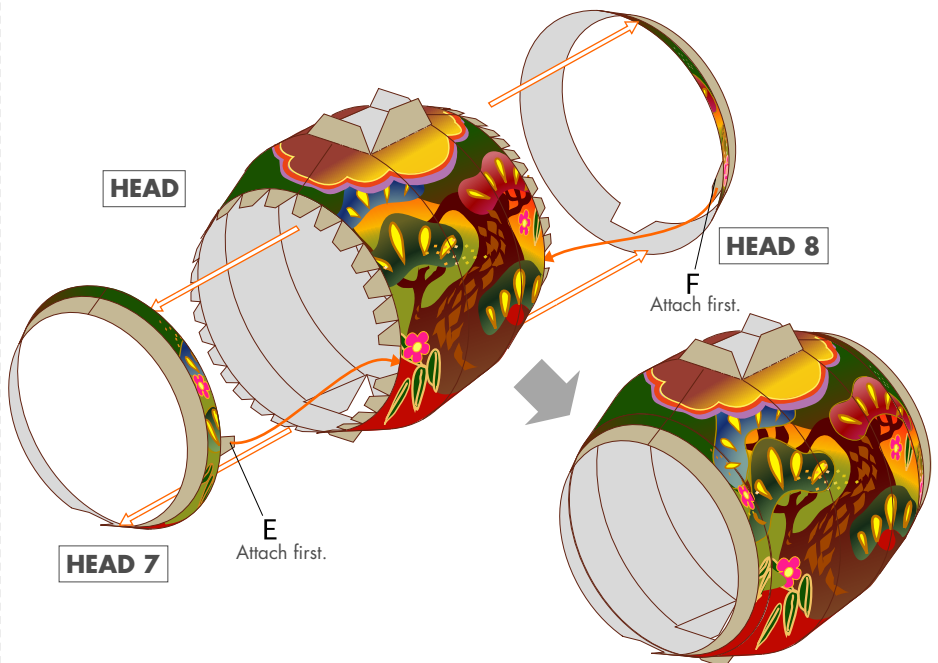


3 Head 7



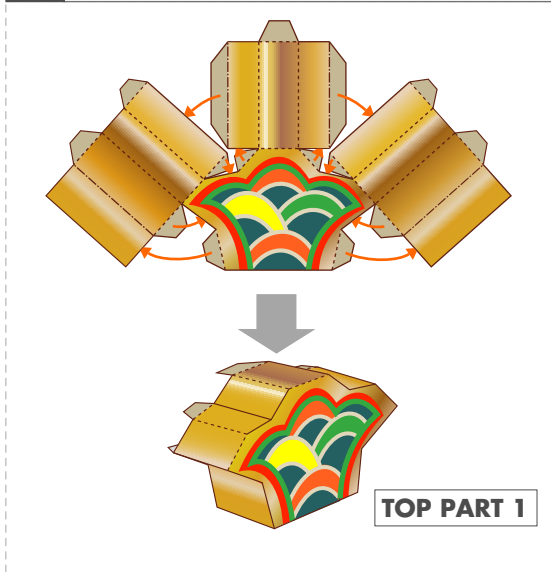
*The head8 in the same.

4 Glue the head 7 and the head 8 to the head

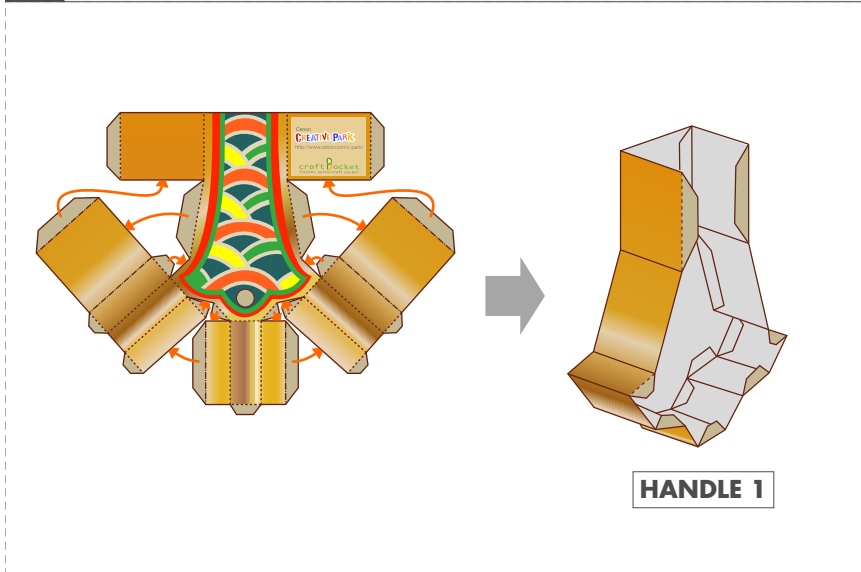


★ Assemble the top part/handle/mallet

5 Top part 1



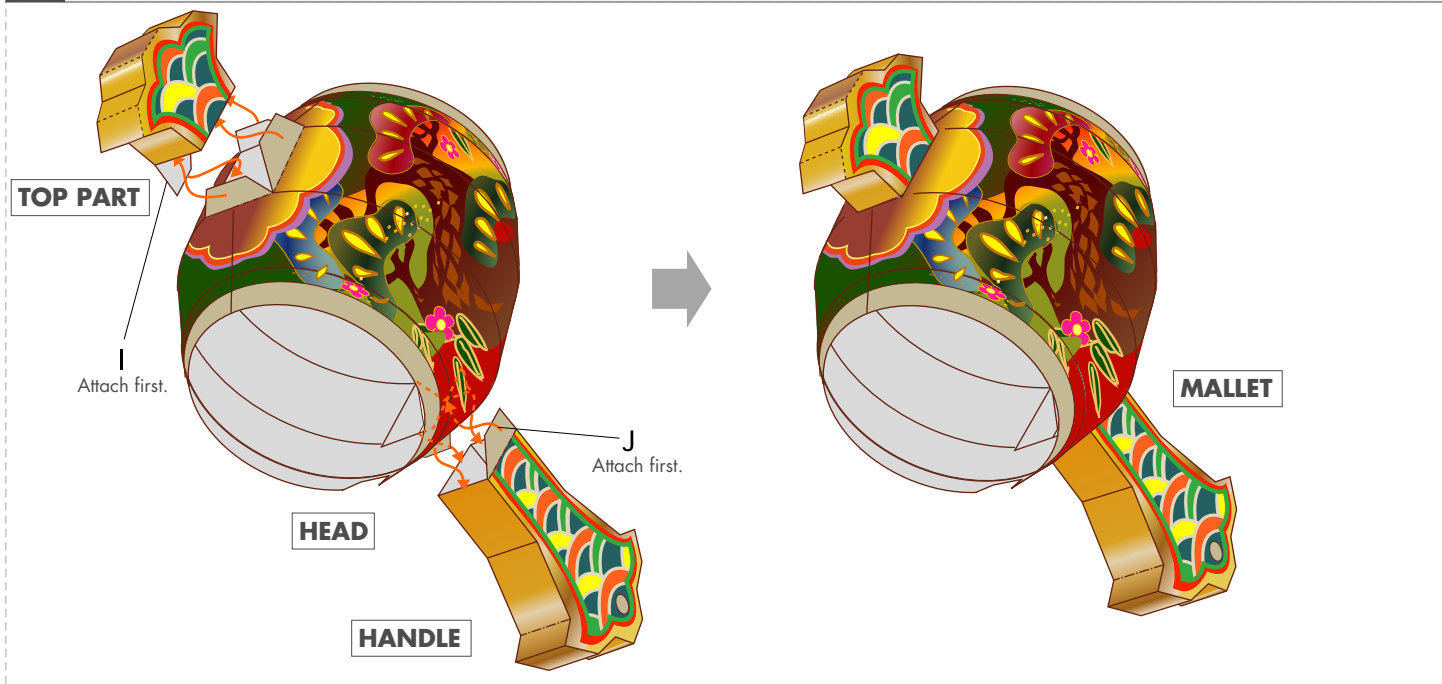
6 Handle 1



7 Glue the top part 1 and the top part 2

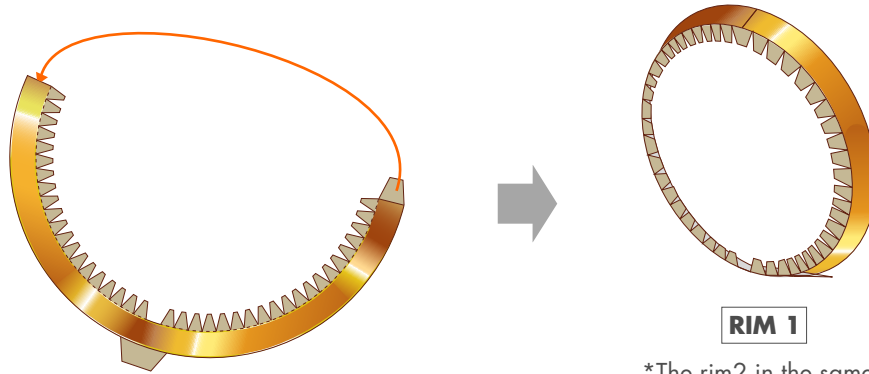


8 Glue the top part and the handle to the head



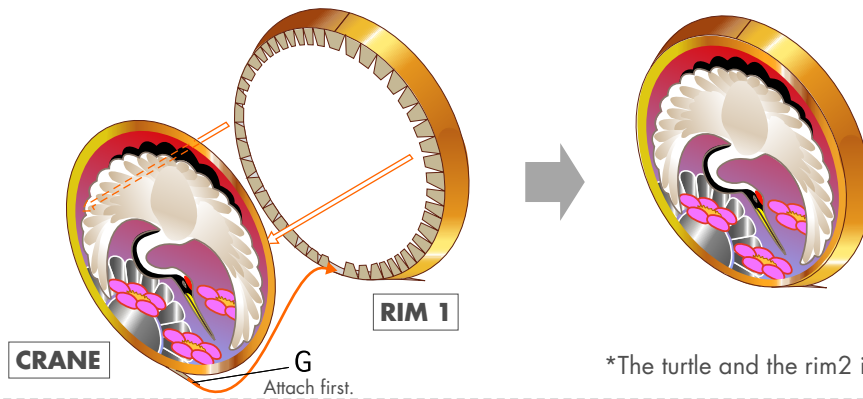
★ Assemble the rim/crane/turtle/mallet

9 Rim(1/2)

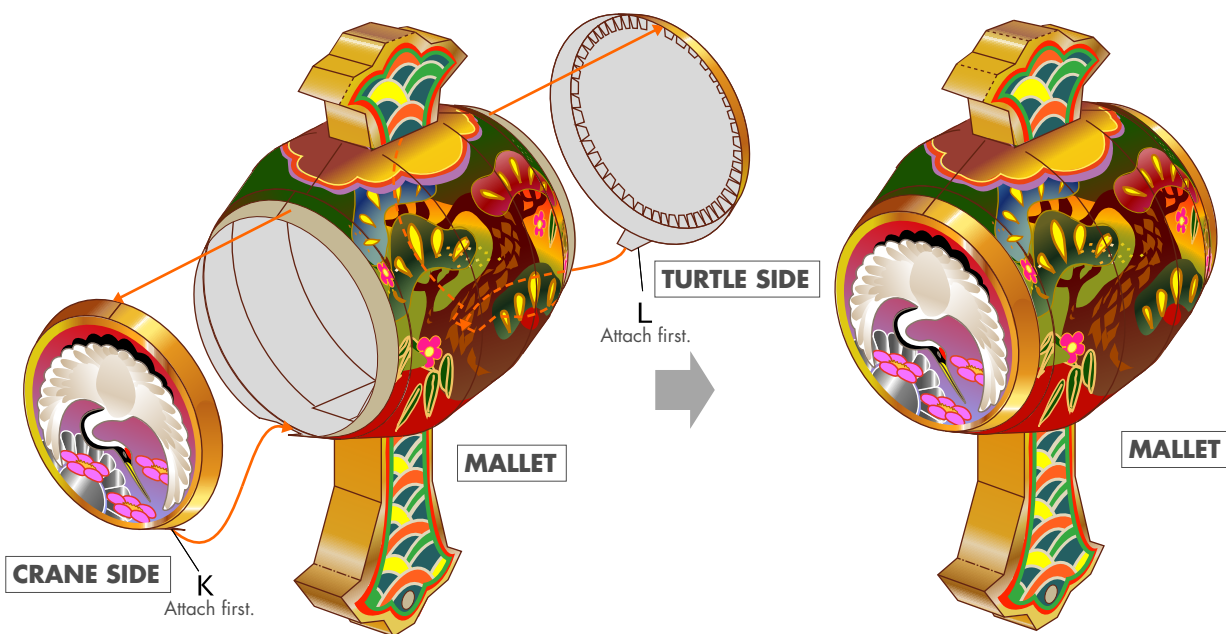


*The rim2 in the same.

10 Attach the crane and the rim 1

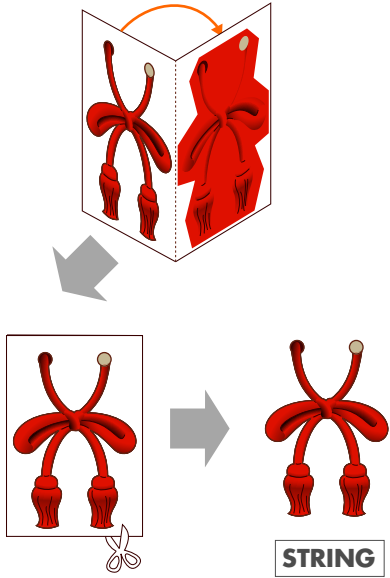


11 Glue the crane side and the turtle side to the mallet



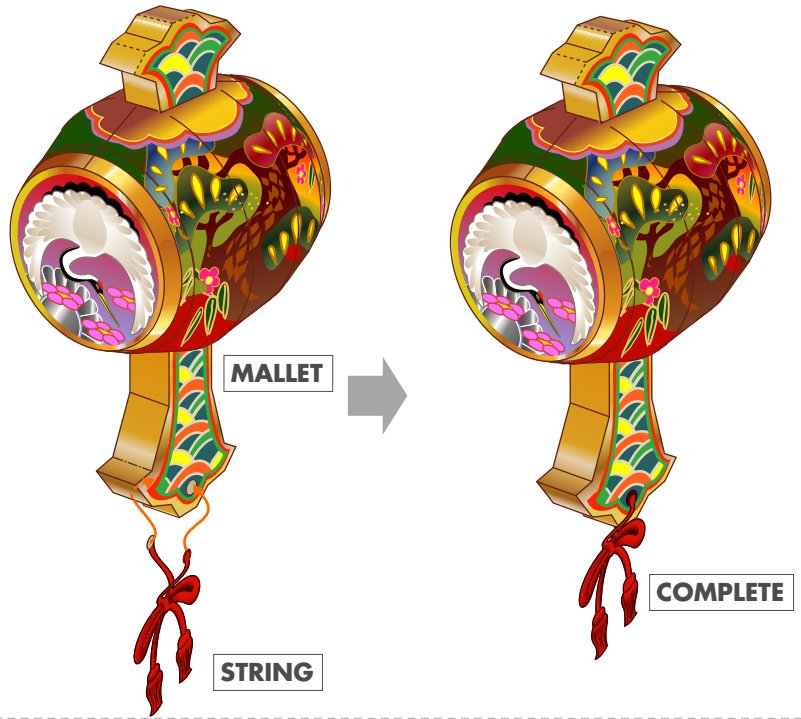
★ Assemble the string
