


Cut out the parts and crease them along the fold lines indicated.



Cut a slot into each side of the ribbon and assemble together.




Attach 2 to the glue tab area of the wreath.





4. Cut the slots on the A glue tabs, and slot them together so that only the white area can be seen (2 sets).




Attach the base together at the glue tab.



5 Attach 4 to the message plate.




8 Attach the rotating stand to the base.



6 Attach the glue tabs on the B glue tabs to make a stand (2 sets).




Attach 5 to the inner most glue tab on the rotating stand (8).





Attach 6 to 9's message plate. Then, attach the left and right holly leaves on top of it.



Place 3 on top of 10. Attach the rotating stand's glue tabs to the A glue tab at the top, and secure 3.

\*After attaching the rotating stand and 3 together and deciding the position, add some glue to the A glue tabs on the message plate. Attach the wreath by pressing it from the top.



12 Add decorations to the wreath - it's up to you!



Stick on a colored paper cover onto half of the rear side of the base paper. Be careful to stick it on in the right direction.



14 13 is the completed card when the cover is stuck on to the other half side.
